Notes:

- Married couples: each spouse should complete a separate Gift Aid Declaration. Each donation has to be recorded against one person. On every donation please indicate which person it is from (in the bank reference or on the envelope).
- You can cancel this declaration at any time by writing to us (by post or email)
- If you stop being a taxpayer it is **IMPORTANT** you tell us so we stop claiming tax (or if you no longer pay enough tax – again you must tell us)
- You must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April one year to 5 April the next) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that the charity will reclaim on your gifts for that tax year. If you are unsure whether you pay enough tax to do Gift Aid please contact us or see the guidance at www.gov.uk/donating-to-charity
- If you change your name or address please tell us in writing (by post or email)
- If you are a higher-rate tax payer you can claim back the higher rate tax via your tax return (potentially £000s) We only claim back the basic rate tax (currently 25p for every £1 you give)
